

## Second Report of WAIK I Nyanza Manga Village Self Help Group

The report was carried out by the project coordinator Mr. Tom Nyangor with the assistance of some village members. It was done on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> of January 2011. On that day 33 households were visited. Some of the comments were:

1. The tube producing clean water was low in rate of releasing water. It was a bother to many households.
2. Some members complained about time consuming when using purifiers.
3. The water from purifiers was found to be extra clean. They said that even colored water becomes colorless when it passes through the purifier.
4. Community agreed to do their own supervisor and monitoring on how to reinforce use of purifiers.
5. They (community) agreed to form a group and elect a committee to check on how purifiers are used.
6. The issue of sharing was a big challenge to some members who were not sure whether the people to be given purifiers would maintain them.

Apart from those comments members agreed to meet on the following day to elect their representatives. On the meeting held on Sunday 30/1/2011 the following were elected:
