

Third Report of WAIK I Nyanza, Manga Hill Self Help Group Held on Saturday 19/2/2011

The report contains the findings which were found out by the respective committee members. They brought comments and challenges as follow:

- Due to continuous use of the clean water chances of some common stomach diseases reduced.
- The ideal work of the purifiers reached its optimum level because it was dry spell and villagers were drawing water down the hills. The water was not good but due to use of purifiers it was found to be clean and ideal for human consumption.
- Some purifiers were found to be somehow blocked. This was so because the water seemed had a lot of mud inside. It was noted that the greatly affected was for Monica Oswago nd Sophia Otete.
- Some of the old village members were not interested in purifiers. Initially one was returned and it was given to another household.

GENERAL REMARK – Change is a gradual issue. The work of monitoring has been ease by respective committee members.

There is a positive change of attitude and members are willing to do some of the activities which will improve their lives. They have intensive education on hygiene, need for people to build pit latrines and general habit of washing hands after making a call and before touching any meal.

Purifiers are good but we hope for permanent solution to the village through God's grace and mercies of our friends and empathizers.
