It has been fine in the whole vilage. People have been harvesting their crops. The types of crops grown in the area include: Maize, millet Groundnuts, beans, greengram, soya beans,etc. It has been a dry spell and water has reduced. It has forced community members to remove mud from the existing wells and streams to allow them get water.

They have been consistently using water purifies. The use has been successfully in several house holds. Some house holds have recorded some slight defects in the purifiers. Some of the tubes leading to clean water harvest is free, e.g. Elsa Adhiabo's purifier. Nicholas Juma's purifier's red tubes was cut by the child using a rezor blade, hence it is sealed by a celotape and it is working. Some of the long tubes connecting the bigger tank (*to the mouthpiece, translators comment*) are almost developing some cracks.

The co-coordinator visited all house holds and confirmed every thing. There will be a general meeting on Sunday 7/08/2011 to teach people on the maintenance of the purifiers.

Generally the lives of the villagers have changed because of constant useifiers. they have not recorded any water borne disease or water related diseases. They have the WAIK PROPONENTS in heart.
